Puppies need to toilet more than you'd think!

Take your puppy out to the toilet:

- After every meal
- After waking up from sleep
- After play or exercise
- After excitement, training or visitors
- At least every hour depending on puppy's age!

Get everyone at home on board with training to help with consistency and to speed up the process!

You'll Need:

- ✓ Puppy training treats
- ✓ Non-ammonia based carpet cleaner for any accidents!
- ✓ Patience and consistency

- ★ Establish a routine- create a regular feeding schedule and dedicated toileting area outside
- ★ Take your puppy out regularly, giving plenty of opportunity to toilet outside.
- ★ Notice signs that your puppy needs to toilet e.g sniffing/circling and take them out ASAP.
- ★ Always go with your puppy in to the garden or toileting area, no matter what the weather
- ★ Once your puppy toilets outside, reward with treats and positive encouragement/praise.
- ★ You can then use a cue word like 'wee-wees' or 'toilet' but only when your dog is toileting.
- ★ Don't discipline for accidents- they will happen! Stay consistent and they'll get it eventually.
- ★ It may help to pen off an area to be used for toileting to keep distractions to a minimum.
